

Safe seats, safe kids

Did you know that over 70% of child car restraints are incorrectly installed or used? To help parents and carers ensure their children are travelling safely on every trip, Kidsafe Victoria have released a free Child Car Restraint E-learning Tool.

HOW: Parents and carers (including grandparents!) can book in a free child car restraint fitting or safety check by registering through the 'Safe Seats Safe Kids' website.

Important Booking Information:

Head to the **'Venue'** section of our website, and select a location near you from the drop down menu. Alternatively, please use the interactive map to click on a location near you.

Bookings are available for one child car restraint fitting/check per appointment slot. If you need to have more than one child car restraint fitted/checked in your vehicle, you will require a separate booking for each child car restraint.

You will be required to acknowledge our terms and conditions of attendance before confirming your booking. Among a number of requirements, these require you to cancel your appointment if you are feeling unwell or experiencing the symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), for the well being of our team and all those attending our venues.

Under the current requirements, it is recommended that masks be worn outdoors when physical distancing can't be maintained

Please undertake our 'safety check' before attending an event to find out if your child car restraint is suitable.
